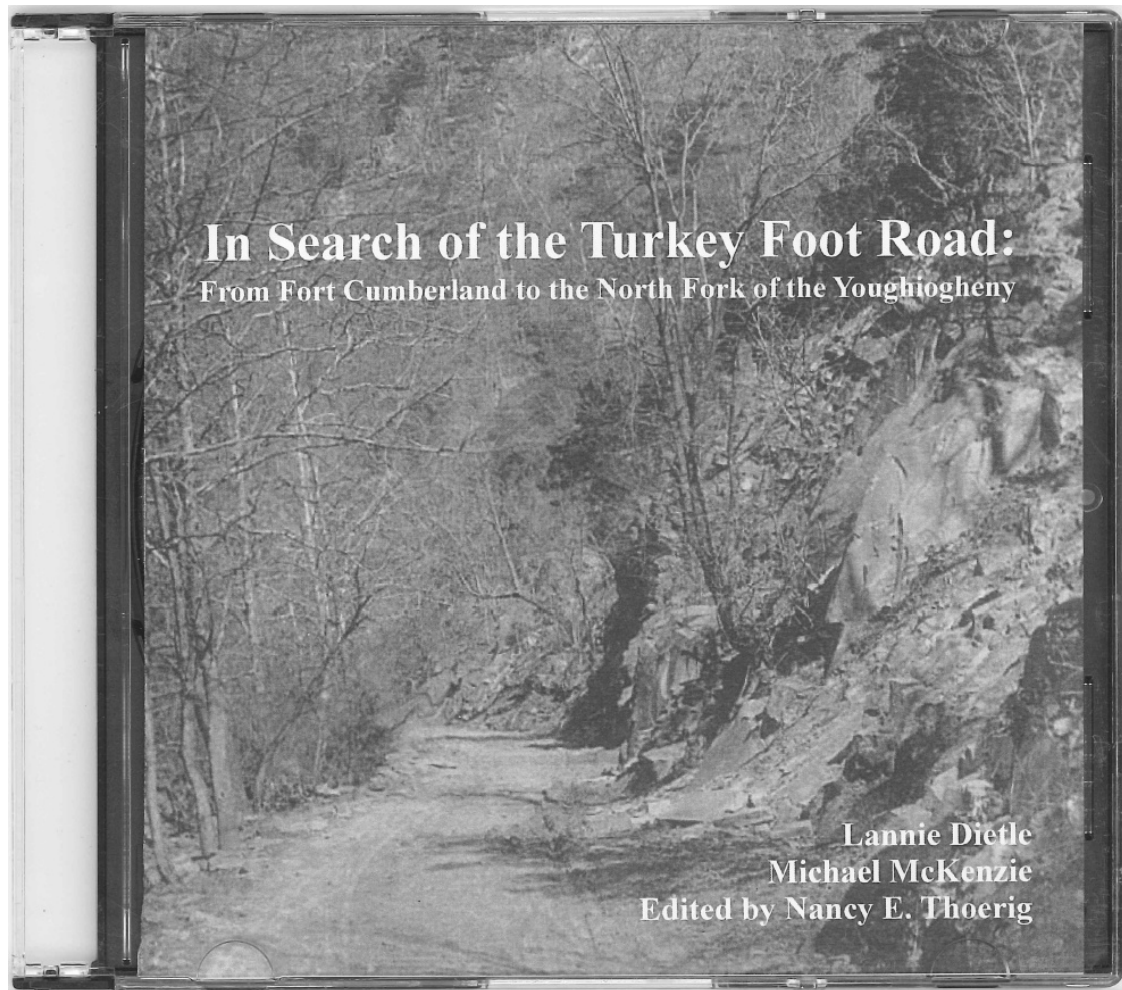


Turkey Foot Road Book



The intensive Turkey Foot Road study that began on Korns.org has been completed, and will be released as a PDF-based e-book in the near future. The book traces the history and route of the legendary Turkey Foot Road that crossed the mountain barrier between the present-day locations of Cumberland, Maryland and Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. It also examines the Indian and bridle path traditions that survive in Mount Savage, Maryland and Salisbury Pennsylvania.

In its heyday, the road was a principal route. As such, it facilitated settlement to the west, and served the transportation needs of those living near it. The route has been identified in considerable detail using maps and property surveys, depression era high resolution aerial photography, crop marks, surviving landscape scars, and oral traditions.
