

NOTE.—It shall be the duty of the Executors and Administrators to make a true and perfect inventory of all the goods, chattels and credits of the decedent, as far as they may know or can ascertain them, and exhibit the same into the Register's office within thirty days from the time administration is granted; and also a just account and settlement thereof in one year, &c. Purdon, 1st vol., p. 414, sec. 49.

NOTE.—All bonds, notes and other evidence of debt, also all other claims and demands for money, or any other personal property owned or held by the decedent, at the time of his decease, shall, as far as the same may be known to his Executors or Administrators, be included in the inventory, to be made and returned as aforesaid.
