

Introduction to the scanned material that begins on Page 2

In the discussion of whether Susanna, the wife of Michael Korns, Sr., could be the daughter of Daniel Boucher and his wife Eva, reference is often made to the suitability of the birth date of Susanna Baucher. The attached 1952 document is an English translation of Berks County, Pennsylvania German language church records that include Susanna Boucher's birth date.

The translation is in a book or booklet titled "Originally named Bethel locally called the Stone Church known officially as the Greenwich Congregation".

The translation, from a section titled "Baptisms", reads "Susanna, daughter of Daniel Bauscher and wife Eva, was born in Albany township, September 28, 1762. Sponsors: Ferdinand Ritter and wofe Susanna in Albany township."

Anna Barbara, daughter of Jacob Triss and Magdalene, was born in Albany township, July 8, 1762. Sponsors were: Tobias Stebelton and wife Barbara.

John Martin, son of Jacob Tonnat [Donat] and wife Catharina, was born in Albany township, on September 2, 1762. Sponsors: John Martin Holtzenhaus and wife Catharine in Lynn township.

(2) John Gerhart, son of Jacob Gernart, and Anna Eva, was born in Albany township, on October 7, 1762. Sponsors: John Weiger (Weier) and Anna Magdalene in Lynn township.

Maria Barbara, daughter of John Adam Schwenck and Dorothea, was born in Albany township, September 15, 1762. Sponsors: Henry Schwenck and Anna Barbara, his wife.

John Creutz, son of John Adam Creutz and Catharine, his wife, was born in Albany township, January 5, 1763. Sponsors: Simon Creutz and Anna Magdalene Hein in Albany township, single.

(3) Susanna, daughter of Daniel Bauscher and wife Eva, was born in Albany township, September 28, 1762. Sponsors: Ferdinand Ritter and wife Susanna in Albany township.

John Peter, son of John Peter Kerber and Anna Elisabetha, was born on July 3, 1763. Sponsors: Michael Dris, Magdalene Hein, single.
