


Daniel Korn's 1864 Civil War Book

The images below show the title page and handwritten entries in Daniel Korn's 1864 book on the Civil War that is titled **Organization of the Army of the Potomac and of its Campaigns in Virginia and Maryland**. I find it interesting that a mountain farmer was reading such a weighty topic. The book came from the family home of Allen Lester Korn of Southampton Township, Somerset county, PA and now belongs to one of his grandchildren. Allen Korn's home was owned previously by his father John Wilson Korn and his grandfather Daniel Korn, Jr.

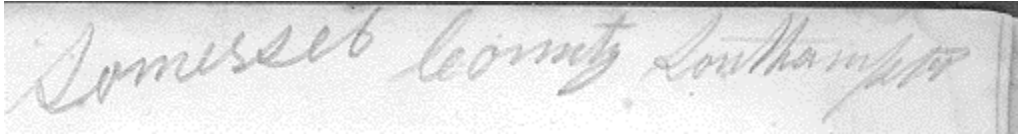


Figure 3: Somerset County Southampton inscription in back of book

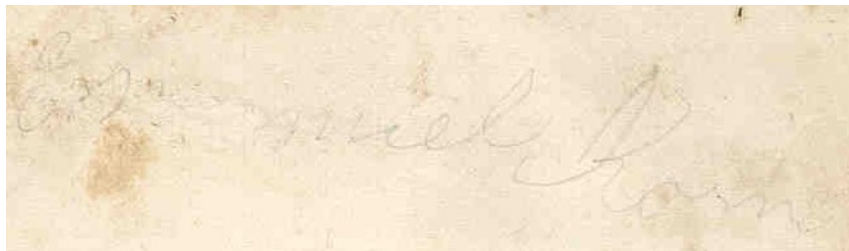


Figure 5: Emanuel Korn's name in back of book

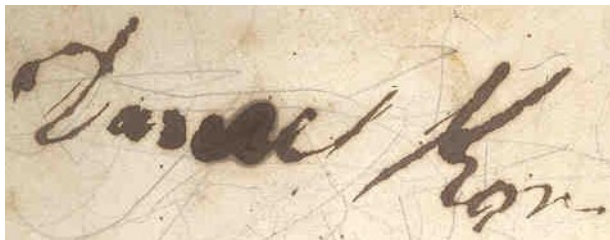


Figure 6: Daniel Korn's name in back of book

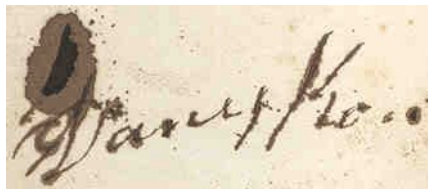


Figure 7: Daniel Korn's name in back of book
