Another bit of proof for Peter Kennel, Sr. being in or near Cumberland, Maryland. A Mr. Lopley, living to-day (1941) told Mrs. Frances Kennel Travis that his great-grandfather and our Henry Kennel went from CUMBERLAND into Southampton township, Somerset county, Pennsylvania.

Our Henry Kennel, Kentle, Kendle appears in the 1810 census records, Southampton township, Somerset County, Pa.

Peter Kentle, Kennel, Kendle, Jr. in 1810 census

Dewald Kentle, Kendle, Kennel, Kenol, appears in the Church records and the Public Sales Records Books, census etc of Washington County Maryland.

The date of birth of Henry Kennel in the census is verified in the Unionville Church records, Reform Congregation, North Whitehall, Lehigh County, Pa.

The father of Henry Kennell was Peter Kennell he was a soldier of the Revolutionary War. There was a Peter listed in the 1810-1820 census, then he is no longer in the census for Southampton township. The father of Peter Shumaker was also a soldier of the Revolutionary War. These are proven records here in D.C.

Christian Kennell the ancestor of Senator Kendall was a brother of Henry's and Christian was born in Maryland. Peter Kennell's son Dewalt Kennell, Kendle, Kentle, Kandle and what have you in the line of spelling is buried at Williamsport, Md. I saw the grave. A man in Hagerstown is also writing this Kennell history and I am helping him here at the census records.

I am helping some 20 people all over the U.S. hunt ancestors, it is a hobby with me and I do not charge them. They exchange data with me. Help me find what I want there in exchange for what I find here.
