### THE FOLLOWING IS A CORRECT TRANSCRIPT FROM THE RECORDS OF THE POST:

Comrade William M. Cleland is 44 years of age, was born in Pennsylvania State of \_\_\_\_\_ and is by occupation a Farmer entered the service on the 27 day of July 1862 as a Private Co. H 155<sup>th</sup> Regt. Penn Infantry and was finally discharged on the 17 day of July 1865 as Sergeant Co. H 155<sup>th</sup> Regt. Penn Infantry by reason of Close of War having served 2 years 11  $\frac{3}{4}$  months. Joined this Post by Muste March 11 1886
